On January 23, 2014 AIHS received official notice from the Canadian Institutes of Health Research that the administrative review of <u>Alberta's SPOR SUPPORT Unit's business plan</u> was approved. The approval means we can proceed to the next phase of negotiations – the signing of the grant agreement between CIHR & AIHS. We anticipate this to occur later this month, which means AIHS would receive the first SPOR SUPPORT Unit federal dollars prior to March 31, 2014.

The recruitment process of the Platform Leads continues. We had a terrific response to the call for Leads from candidates with strong backgrounds and experience. The <u>SPOR Steering Committee</u> reviewed the applications on January 24, 2014, and candidates have now been selected for interviews in March 2014. The calibre of applications was impressive and the Committee hopes to engage all candidates in the development/rollout of the SPOR SUPPORT Unit.
